Roads Water and Sewer Report

Roads:

Where service lines were replaced, patching was done. Other areas in town are deteriorating and need to be patched.

Water:

Our biggest issue is the low precipitation causing potential water shortages this year. Conservation measures should be adopted by all. The flag system will be implemented as necessary. Attached is a resolution that will give us the authority to adopt a drought emergency plan.

Work continues to get the plant operating as designed. The loan/grant is in progress. We will continue to use Paul Rose and Acumen Engineering to identify needed steps.

Ten service line were replaced as maintenance items. The hydrant at the top of Spruce was extended to meet code requirements.

Samples have been taken and tested as required.

The boil order remains in effect.
