Roads Water and Sewer Report

Roads:

I was advised of a dying tree on Tamarack Street that could adversely impact several homeowners. I called and was able to get it removed.

Water:

Spring flow is averaging 17 gpm. Use was exceeding that and a red flag was displayed. A drought contingency plan is being developed to indicate flows, usage, and water saving measures to be implemented. I asked Mike to give us daily reports to better monitor use. I suggested a town-wide "no-use" period (1/2 hr) on a certain date to see if we have leaks. Samples have been taken and tested as required.

I made a phone call to Truckee Fire Dept to advise them that we have low water storage. They replied and said they would advise the staff to bring tenders if responding.

The boil order remains in effect.

Sewer:

Issues were reported: Ida Wilson called and said that Jess Bailey and Dennis Jameson excavated and connected to the sewer on Willow. This is in violation of the Bylaws. I inspected and found it to be true. I told Jess it was illegal and needs to be removed.

I did an inspection of the tank, monitoring wells and leech field with Mike Smith. All indications are that the system is working properly.

Quarterly reports were compiled and submitted as required.

Power meters were read, recorded and forwarded.

Cleanup Day:

We filled two dumpsters and ordered a third which was also filled. We stockpiled brush near the dumpsters and paid to have it chipped.
