Roads Water and Sewer Report

Roads: There were no issues reported with the roads.

Water: Dennis Jameson was authorized to install a shut-off valve at Baileys property and to repair the leak at the base of cedar street. Paul and /or Mike should be present at this board meeting for updates on the treatment plant.

Andregg Geotechnics was contacted to provide a survey of the schoolhouse parcel to determine feasibility of use area for possible future water tank placement. Corners were found and it appears to be enough room for needed items.

Samples have been tested as required. The boil order remains in effect.

Sewer: Dennis Jameson was authorized to repair the illegal sewer on Baileys property to as close as possible to the previous condition. A below grade cap on the illegal hookup as close to the main is advised. This could also be converted to a main clean-out for that area

The inspection ports that were damaged by Liberty Energy were repaired. A compilation of costs will be submitted to Liberty Energy for reimbursement. Samples have been taken and submitted for testing as required.

Power meters were read and recorded as required.

Top Dog Timber was contacted to prepare a bid for the removal of trees and brush that are impacting the school-house.
