

Roads, Water and Sewer Report . Dec 5th 2013

Roads:

There were no issues reported with the roads.

A snow removal contract with Jess Bailey was approved.

Water:

Samples were taken and submitted for testing as required.

The boil order remains in effect.

Acumen Engineering has been directed to address the following:

A larger tank may be necessary to provide a settling basin to allow solids to settle before water reaches the plant. This would reduce the load on the filter system, and provide more storage capacity. Location, size and specifics need to be determined. An additional pump may be required to push the water through the system and back up to the distribution tank. The proper backwash filter system that is necessary for ideal plant performance needs to be determined.

Jess Bailey has indicated in his opinion, that the water service for the Willow St property passes under an adjacent lot that he owns and is not a legal installation. This was done before he purchased the property and could be considered "grandfathered" in with an easement for FPOA.

Sewer:

Jess Bailey has indicated in his opinion, that the sewer line for the Willow St. property passes under an adjacent lot that he owns and is not a legal installation. This was done before he purchased the property and could be considered "grandfathered" in with an easement for FPOA.
